Morgan Marine Ltd recognises its Environmental responsibility and is committed to significantly reducing its impacts on the environment, whilst maintaining high standards of quality and customer service. Its main impacts consist of energy consumption, waste disposal, low level solvent emissions and its use of potentially harmful chemicals.

To support this commitment, we will:

- Comply with all Environmental legislation applicable to our operations.
- Communicate the importance of environmental responsibility through training and awareness.
- Regularly publish details of pollution, waste management and fuel/energy consumption.
- Prevent pollution through control procedures and provision of control equipment.
- Minimise energy and water consumption through regular monitoring and investigation into efficiency methods.

- Review and where necessary revise the Environmental Awareness training.

- Ensure the outcome of investigations into environmental incidents and near misses are appropriately communicated to prevent recurrence.

All Morgan Marine Ltd employees will:

- Follow the requirements of the Environmental Management System (EMS).
- Report all environmental incidents and near misses immediately.

ARRANGEMENTS

Morgan Marine Ltd will:

- Operate and maintain an Environmental Management System that corresponds to the requirements of ISO 14001:2015 with additional commitment to achieving third party accreditation to this standard.
- Ensure that all employees and sub-contract staff are sufficiently trained, experienced and where applicable, supervised to a standard sufficient to minimise harm to the natural and built environment.
- Monitor compliance via periodic inspections and compliance audits. Compliance will be reviewed at monthly Senior Management meetings and at the annual review.
- Take corrective actions where deficiencies are highlighted and implement preventative measures to prevent reoccurrence.
- Make this policy available throughout the group and to other interested parties.
